

Muslim unity a strategy for Iran: Raisi

Iranian President Ayatollah Ebrahim Raisi has underlined the need for unity among Muslims, saying the Islamic Republic considers this unity a strategy and not a tactic.

Speaking at the opening ceremony for the 36th International Islamic Unity Conference in Tehran, Raisi pointed out that holding this meeting can play a significant role in promoting unity among Muslims.

"The role of scholars, prominent people, cultured people, history makers, and future makers is irreplaceable. Today, unity is not a tactic for us, but a very basic strategy," Raisi said, according to the official website of the Iranian presidency. Ayatollah Raisi stated, "The meaning of this statement and the translation of this view is that whoever contributes to the unity of the Islamic world by writing, speaking, deed... has moved in the direction of the necessary strategy of the Islamic world."

At the ceremony, Raisi congratulated the birth of the Prophet of Islam and Imam Jafar Sadiq (AS) and said, "The comprehensiveness of Islam can meet all the needs of today's mankind and contemporary man can create a happy life for himself by relying on God, self-confidence and religious learning."

He added, "The comprehensiveness of Islam meets all the needs of contemporary man and gives him the strength to stand against cultures that are not compatible with religious life." Thanking the attendees of the conference, Ayatollah Raisi said, "This meeting will lead to a common understanding among all influential figures in the Islamic world regarding the huge capital called religion and religious values; a great capital in the name of religious people and Muslims and believers in religion, as well as Islamic lands, which today with all the material and spiritual wealth are at the disposal of Muslims."

Raisi considered educated young people with a tendency towards spirituality, the spirit of resistance and standing against the enemy, readiness to take risks in the path of a religious life as other great assets of the Islamic world.

"The thinkers of the Islamic world are a great asset who are ready to stand together from various fields, universities and scientific and research centers against atheistic thinking, secular trend, takfiri and extremist thinking."

Pointing out that men and women in Islamic countries are ready to unite with each other in the name of religion and frustrate the enemies, President Raisi stressed the need to understand the tricks of the enemy in downplaying the abilities of Muslims and exaggerating their own incapacity.

He added, "The flag that Imam Khomeini (RA) raised was the flag of unity between all Muslims all over the world, with all dialects, in all regions and with all viewpoints."

Ayatollah Raisi further referred to the synergistic capacity of Islamic countries and said, "Today, Muslims have many commonalities that can create a great religious and civilizing power in the world and stand tall and raise their flag."

President Raisi went on to say that the main message of the 36th Islamic Unity Conference is to create a common understanding among all elites and intellectuals of the Islamic world in direction of unity.

"The message of this summit to enemies is that we want the life of contemporary man to be in the name of the religion."

Referring to the important role of the martyrs of the global Islamic movement in awakening the nations, Ayatollah Raisi clarified, "Those who thought that religion is an individual and personal matter and has nothing to do with social, economic, political and cultural affairs, have awakened throughout the world thanks to the pure blood of the martyrs."



Export from Kermanshah province rises 7% in 6 months yr/yr



The value of export from Kermanshah province, in the west of Iran, rose seven percent in the first six of the current Iranian calendar year (March 21- September 22), as compared to the same period of time in the previous year, an official with the customs department of the province announced.

Bakhtiar Rahmani-pour said that commodities worth \$1.305 billion were exported from the province in the said time span, indicating also two percent rise in terms of weight.

He named rebar, hardware, ceramic tiles, fruits and vegetables, constructional stones, dairy products, plastic products,

and disposable containers as the major exported items.

The official further announced that commodities worth \$33.858 million were imported to the province in the first half of this year, showing two percent rise year on year.

The main imported goods during this period included aluminum alloy and production line equipment, he said.

As previously announced by the official, the value of export from Kermanshah province rose 15 percent in the past Iranian calendar year 1400 (ended on March 20), from its preceding year.

Rahmani-pour said that 525.305 million tons of commodities

worth \$2.723 billion were exported from the province in the previous year.

In terms of the weight, the exports also indicate three percent annual growth, he added.

He named ceramics and tiles, rebars, iron products, fruits and vegetables, constructional stones, dairy products, and plastic products as the main exported items.

The official further announced that 25,804 tons of products worth \$66.351 million were imported to the province in the past year, indicating 10 percent growth in terms of value.

He named aluminum alloy, factory production line, batteries,

and tires as the major imported items.

The data released by Islamic Republic of Iran Customs Administration (IRICA) showed that the value of Iran's non-oil export rose 13.3 percent during the first half of the present year, as compared to the same period of time in the past year.

Based on an IRICA report, the country's six-month non-oil exports stood at 51.783 million tons valued at \$24.251 billion, with a 12.5-percent decline in weight.

Liquefied propane, methanol, liquefied butane, liquefied natural gas and film grade polyethylene were the main exported

products in the said time span, accounting for 25.6 percent of the total value of the exports.

Major export destinations of the Iranian non-oil goods were China with \$7.842 billion of imports, Iraq with \$3.382 billion, the United Arab Emirates (UAE) with \$3.112 billion, Turkey with \$2.626 billion, and India with \$904 million.

According to IRICA data, the Islamic Republic has also imported 16.32 million tons of non-oil commodities worth \$26.31 billion in the first six months of the present year, with a 13.15-percent growth in value and a 14.72-percent decrease in weight, year on year.

The first five items of goods imported into the country in the first half of this year include rice, wheat, maize, soybeans and mobile phones. The mentioned items accounted for 20.63 percent of the total import value during this period.

The United Arab Emirates with \$7.206 billion was the top exporter to Iran in the said period, followed by China with \$6.846 billion, Turkey with \$2.680 billion, India with \$1.380 billion, and Russia with \$876 million worth of exports.

Reportedly, the value of Iran's non-oil trade rose 13.2 percent during the first six months of the present year, as compared to the same period of time in the past year.

Inhumane sanctions impose devastating effects on health system



The inhumane sanctions have had devastating effects on the health system and the question is who is responsible for the deaths of some innocent patients due to the lack of essential medicines, Health Minister Bahram Einollahi has said.

He made the remarks at the 69th session of the Regional Committee for the Eastern Mediterranean, being held in Cairo, Egypt on October 10-13. Amidst all the efforts across the

globe to contain COVID-19, my country suffers from inhumane and illegal economic sanctions.

These unilateral coercive measures constitute a serious obstacle to the fulfillment of countries' fundamental right to obtain and access the necessary means to contain and defeat COVID-19, he explained.

On a different point, Iran and other developing countries that have developed their own vaccines, expect the

WHO to facilitate and expedite the registration process in order to obtain EUL. Whilst, in the battle against Omicron, vaccines remain the most effective public health intervention to protect people from COVID-19, the current approach would not serve the goal of a successful global response to the COVID-19 pandemic, he further stated.

Furthermore, Access to the COVID-19 Accelerator Tool (ACT-A), which was launched for fair and equitable access to public goods failed to remove barriers to public access. Thus, it is important to ensure compliance and consistency throughout the envisaged line of activities.

Vaccine hesitancy and poor community engagement are still prevalent across the world. Further work is required to raise awareness because no one is safe until everyone is safe, he also said.

Einollahi said in July that despite the sanctions that have existed since the beginning of the Islamic Revolution to prevent the country from progressing, Iran has the strongest health system in the region.

Impact of sanctions on patients Alena Douhan, the UN Human Rights Council's Special Rapporteur, said in September that she has been greatly affected by the impact of sanctions on Iranian citizens suffering from "genetic diseases" or "cancer".

"It has usually been maintained that unilateral sanctions are imposed by 'good guys on bad guys' for some 'supreme purpose' and with good intentions, but unfortunately in reality that is the people of the country who are affected enormously," she noted. In a report published in September on the effects of decades of embargoes on Iran, Douhan said that sanctions had affected nearly every aspect of life in Iran.

The provision of medicines and medical equipment to Iran was "severely undermined" by sanctions on finance, trade, shipping, insurance and over-compliance on the part of foreign businesses and suppliers, she added.

"These constitute serious impediments to the enjoyment of the right to the highest attainable standard of health by all Iranians," she stressed.

'10TC prepared for maximum oil export'



Iran is not only a leading country in addiction prevention but also in the treatment and rehabilitation of addicts, Robin Nandy, United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) representative

in Iran has said. He made the remarks on Tuesday at the opening ceremony of the first health and empowerment center for girls in Mashhad, Khorasan Razavi.

He also praised Iran's determination in the fight against addiction in children and teenagers, especially in girls, IRNA reported.

Noting that cognitive and behavioral approaches can help empower and strengthen the resilience and skills of vulnerable teenagers and young people, he said that if these services are provided well, the quality and effectiveness of drug prevention, treatment, and care approaches increase.

In the past years, the United Nations Children's Fund has provided support and various measures with the aim of developing and implementing family and school-based programs for the prevention of addiction.

\$1.4m allocated to addiction treatment A total of 410 billion rials (nearly \$1.4 million) is proposed for the treatment of addiction and reduction of its social harm from the Health Insurance Or-

ganization's share of the budget bill for the current calendar year which started on March 21.

In June, Alexander Fedulov, the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) Representative in Iran Country, attached special importance to the regional and global role of Iran in the fight against narcotics and announced readiness to provide practical assistance to the country in this regard. Iran holds the record for narcotics confiscation in the world, Eskandar Momeni, the director of anti-narcotics police headquarters said in December 2021.

However, great achievements in the field of countermeasures have been gained, and the United Nations has officially announced that 90 percent of opium, 70 percent of morphine, and 20 percent of world heroin have been discovered by Iran.

Iranian universities moving toward international standards

Iran's Minister of Science, Research, and Technology Mohammad-Ali Zolfagholi said that the ministry is making effort to make universities across the country meet international standards.

Iranian graduates can easily be accepted in foreign universities, he further stated. Currently, 3.2 million students are studying in universities across the country, Zolfagholi noted, adding, about 20,000 doctorate students graduate annually. Also, about 700,000 master's students graduate annually. He went on to state that attracting international students aims to strengthen scientific diplomacy.

Stating that 78,000 scientific documents were published by Iran last year, he highlighted that some of the articles were published with the participation of professors and researchers from foreign countries. This indicates that researchers from other countries want to cooperate with Iran.

Academic quality

Most recently, the Leiden ranking system published the 2022 report, according to which 44 Iranian universities were among the 1,318 top universities in the world. Also, the Iran University of Medical Sciences has been ranked as the world's leading university for contributing to delivering the UN's Sustainable Development Goal of good health and well-being. Fifty-eight universities from Iran were listed among the top universities in Asia, according to the 2022 Asia University Rankings of the Times Higher Education. The 2022 edition of the Times Higher Education Impact Rankings, based on universities' contributions to delivering the UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), listed 27 Iranian universities.

The Webometrics Ranking of World Universities 2022 has ranked 694 Iranian institutions among 30,000 top universities across the world. Also, 59 Iranian universities have been listed among the top 3,000 institutions in the world in terms of academic quality, according to the 2021-2022 report released by University Ranking by Academic Performance (URAP).

The Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) Graduate Employability Rankings 2022 list has been released, which included three Iranian universities out of a total of 550 institutes worldwide that highlighted graduate employment processes.

Meanwhile, 41 Iranian universities in engineering sciences and 12 universities in computer sciences have made a place among the top 1,188 universities in the world with the announcement of Higher Education World University Rankings 2022 by subject.

It also has introduced 59 Iranian universities among the top institutions in World University Rankings 2022.

Raisi orders preparation of next year's budget bill

Iranian President Ebrahim Raisi, in a decree on Tuesday, ordered government entities involved in the preparation of the next year's national budget bill to officially start working on the draft of the bill, ISNA reported. As reported, the president's order includes five annexes that cover

the schedule for drafting the bill, financial regulations of the budget bill, instructions and budget forms of executive bodies, comprehensive instructions for performance-based budgeting, and budget instructions for public companies. President Raisi has stressed cre-

ating economic stability, ensuring justice, making the governance system more efficient and reforming the budget structure, implementing practical development plans, as well as implementing active labor market policies in the process of budget bill preparation.

Iran president due in Astana on Thursday

Iranian President Ayatollah Ebrahim Raisi will arrive in Astana, Kazakhstan, to participate in a regional summit aimed at fostering interaction and cooperation in Asia. President Raisi will participate in the sixth summit of the Conference on Interaction and Confidence-Building Measures in Asia (CICA) which will be held in Astana from October 12-13.

The summit will welcome 11 presidents from Azerbaijan, Iraq, Iran, Qatar, Kyrgyzstan, Palestine, Russia, Tajikistan, Turkey, and Uzbekistan, according to Kazakh media. President of Belarus Alexander Lukashenko will participate as an observer at the sixth CICA summit. Vice-Presidents of Vietnam and China will also attend the summit.

Nearly 50 delegations from member states, observer states, observer organizations, partner organizations, and guests of the chairmanship are expected to attend. Mohammad Jamshidi, the director of the Iranian president's office for political affairs, said President Raisi will arrive in Astana on Thursday for the CICA summit.

"We had several requests for meetings with the president, but due to the lack of opportunity, priority is given to the heads of countries that have not been met in previous meetings such as the Shanghai Cooperation Organization and the United Nations General Assembly," Jamshidi told state news agency IRNA.

Jamshidi mentioned the leaders of Qatar and the Republic of Azerbaijan as personalities who requested to meet with Raisi and did not have the opportunity to meet with the president at the Shanghai meeting and the UN General Assembly. In August last year, President Raisi met with the Executive Director of the Secretariat of CICA, Kairat Sarybay, in Tehran.

"Iran believes that the dynamism of regional organizations is a very important factor to counter unilateralism," Raisi said in the meeting. He added, "The Islamic Republic of Iran intends to effectively take advantage of the capacity of regional and international institutions to defend the rights and interests of independent countries."

In the meeting, Sarybay also expressed hope for the continuation and strengthening of the constructive role of the Islamic Republic in the CICA mechanism to promote peace and security in the region and the world, adding, "Today, Asia has an important role in managing global developments, and CICA seeks to strengthen the role of Asian countries in the international stage."

He added, "The focus of the activities of CICA is on strengthening the role of Asian countries in resolving the issues of the continent and preventing the involvement of non-Asian countries in the developments of this continent."

You Should Eat More Soup: 5 Reasons Why

Can soup be a main meal? The answer to this question is both yes and no. Many soups are full of vegetables. Although soups along with a main meal are effective in satiety, they usually can not cause complete satiety alone.

Of course, consuming soup with breads made from wholemeal flour or by adding cereals such as barley to it, will increase calories and turn it into a complete dinner. All in all, it can be said that eating soup with whole grains can make it a relatively light main meal.

1. They're good for you. While some soups can devastate a diet (cream-based varieties can be particularly high in fat and calories), most serve as a great vehicle to meet your daily quota for veggies. View soups as an opportunity to cash in on nature's bounty (winter crops, including pumpkin, butternut squash, carrots and parsnips, won't wilt or get limp when you cook them). If you have produce that's about to pass its prime, tossing them into a soup recipe can give them new life. You can even drop frozen vegetables into boiling broth without compromising taste or texture.

2. They're inexpensive and easy to prepare. Soups and stews don't require a large amount of hands-on time. In fact, if you use a slow cooker or a pressure cooker like the Instant Pot, you can prepare a savory soup in five minutes flat, and let the cooker do the rest of the work. If you amp up the liquid

and vegetables, you can use smaller amounts of expensive ingredients, such as chicken, fish and beef. Then, make it a meal with whole-grain bread on the side and a small salad if you like.

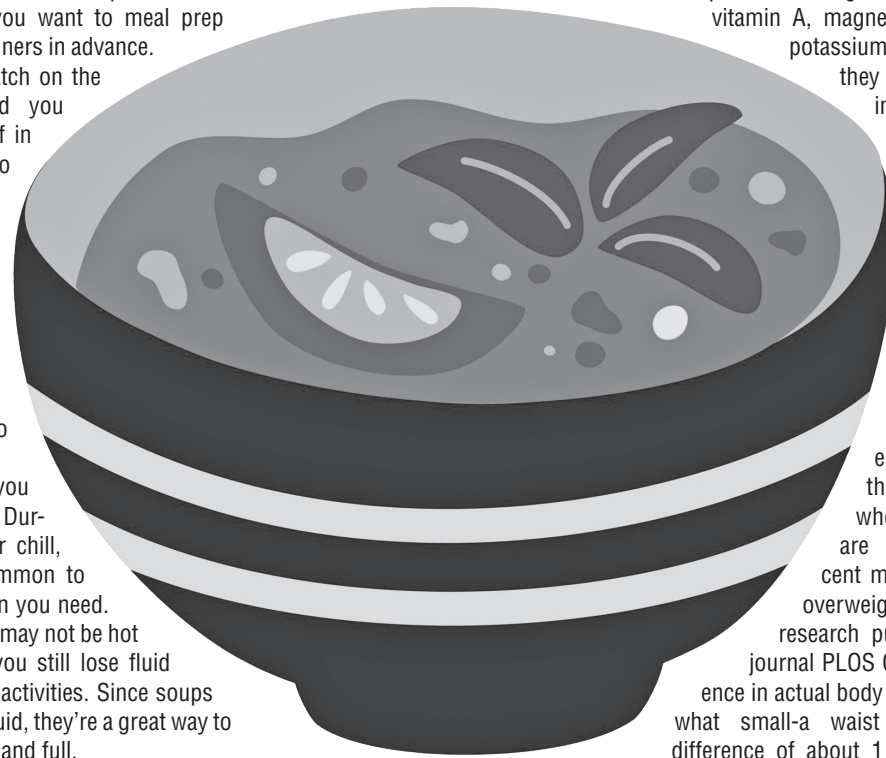
3. They freeze well. Soup and stews are great if you want to meal prep lunches or dinners in advance.

Whip up a batch on the weekend, and you can stash half in the freezer to enjoy later. A bonus: you'll have healthy, homemade soup at the ready when you're busy, under the weather or too tired to cook.

4. They keep you hydrated. During the winter chill, it's not uncommon to drink less than you need. But while you may not be hot and sweaty, you still lose fluid through daily activities. Since soups are mostly liquid, they're a great way to stay hydrated and full.

5. They give your immune system a boost. Soups can help you stave off cold and flu, and they're a great antidote for times when you are sick, too! Most soups are loaded with dis-

ease-fighting nutrients. In fact, studies show that chicken soup in particular can help prevent the common cold, especially if you load it up with fresh garlic, onions, celery and carrots. (They all contain powerful immune-boosting



chemicals.) A bonus: the hot liquid helps soothe a sore throat.

6. Soup Adds Vitamins and Minerals .Do you have a souper diet? (See what

we did there?) The answer is probably "yes" if you're a soup eater. Looking at the diets of 10,500 Americans, Iowa State University researchers found that people who ate soup had higher diet quality scores than people who didn't. Soup eaters had higher intakes of fiber, vitamin A, magnesium, iron and potassium. And overall,

they got more servings of vegetables (notably, more dark greens, orange veggies and legumes).

7. Soup Is the Ultimate Skinny Food .Compared to people who enjoy soup on the regular, those who skip the slurp are about 40 percent more likely to be overweight, according to research published in the journal PLOS ONE. The difference in actual body size was somewhat small—a waist circumference difference of about 1 1/4 inches—but we think that's pretty remarkable considering participants served up soup just once a week. Plus, another study out of Penn State reported that eating soup before lunch helped people natu-

rally cut 134 calories out of their entire meal. 8. You Can Eat More for Fewer Calories .When you include soup in your meal, you're likely to eat a larger portion of food that's also lower in calories. The same Penn State study mentioned above found that people who had soup before lunch enjoyed about 27 ounces of food—the soup plus a pasta entree, for about 820 calories—while those who didn't start with soup ate about 15 ounces of just the pasta for about 930 calories. Other research shows that diets rich in foods that fill you up with fewer calories, like soup, are associated with a lower risk of developing type 2 diabetes. 9. The Sodium Is Offset by Potassium .Soup is notoriously high in sodium—and yes, research shows that people who eat soup do get more sodium than those who skip the bowl. They're also likely to get more potassium. This is important for heart health because potassium encourages your body to excrete sodium. So, while too much sodium can raise blood pressure, potassium can help bring it back down. Not all lunches can say that. A homemade sandwich made with ham, cheese, tomato and whole wheat bread has over 800 mg of sodium and only 320 mg of potassium, but a basic vegetable soup has about 640 mg of sodium and 718 mg potassium. That's 20 percent of your recommended dose of potassium for the day!

Generating 88,000MW electricity is Iran's privilege in SCO

The Deputy Minister of Energy for Electricity and Energy Affairs said generating 88,000 megawatts (MW) of electricity by the Islamic Republic of Iran is an advantage that the country brings for the Shanghai Cooperation Organization.

The existence of more than 88,000-MW electricity capacity in the country is an asset for the Shanghai Cooperation Organization, Homayoon Haeri stated on Tuesday, Mehr News Agency reported.

He said that the high potential of Iran's electricity grid both in terms of production and internal electricity networks is a suffi-

cient condition for the presence of Iran in the Shanghai Cooperation Organization.

Turning to the construction of power plants, Haeri pointed out that Iran enjoys high potential and capabilities in the construction of power plants which can be very effective in exchanging energy with the SCO's member states.

Earlier, Iranian Minister of Energy Ali Akbar Mehrabian had said that exchanging electricity with the SCO member states will be put atop the agenda, adding that Iran has presently established electricity exchange with some of the SCO member states.



Intl. stone expo kicks off central Iran

The 14th International Iran Stone Exhibition opened in Mahallat county in Iran's Markazi Province on Tuesday, IRNA reported.

The four-day exhibition was opened in a ceremony attended by senior officials including the deputy industry minister, some foreign ambassadors, as well as tradesmen and artists active in the decorative stone industry at Nimvar Stone Exhibition Center in Mahallat county. The space of the exhibition was enlarged by 30 percent in comparison to its area last year, so the expo is being held in an area as big as 90,000 square meters.

The Nimvar Center stands second in size after the Construction Industry

Exhibition in Tehran. It also ranks sixth in terms of exhibition space after Italy, China, Turkey, Brazil, and India.

The current year's exhibition provides stone suppliers with the opportunity to exhibit 32,000 tons of decorative stones extracted from 500 mines in 29 provinces throughout the country. Some 21,000 tons of decorative stones from 350 mines across Iran were showcased in the last year's similar exhibition.

Some 16 training courses are scheduled to be held on the sidelines of the international exhibition.

Speaking at the opening ceremony of the exhibition, Cuban Ambassador to Tehran Alberto Gonzalez Casals said

that Iran's stone industry is of global fame. Casals said that Iran's stone industry is of high quality and variety and Cuban businesses are ready to work with Iranian companies in this sector.

The ambassador said that Cuba does not have large mines like Iran's and is ready to purchase Iranian products and leverage Iranian technology in this regard.

He also noted that Iran and Cuba could neutralize sanctions against both countries through serious collaborations, urging Iran to focus on Latin America. The Cuban diplomat vowed that his country would hold an exhibition of Iranian products, including stone industry and mining.

H1 natural gas output rises 4,000 mcm/yr



Iran's natural gas production in the first six months of the current Iranian calendar year (March 21-September 22) increased by 4,000 million cubic meters (mcm) or one percent compared to the previous year's same period, an official with the National Iranian Gas Company (NIGC) said.

According to NIGC's Head of Production Coordination and Supervision Management Ahmad Zamani, sour gas extraction was increased by three percent in the said six months, while an 18-percent increase was also achieved in LPG production.

Speaking in an NIGC roundtable on the challenges of natural gas supply in the cold season, Zamani noted that the overhaul program of the country's gas facilities is almost completed and will be wrapped up by the end of the current Iranian cal-

endar month (October 22). He put the capacity of the country's natural gas production at one billion cubic meters per day and said that the production of sweet gas in the country is currently 840 to 850 mcm per day.

\$4b invested for smartening gas network

Also speaking in the roundtable, Jalal Nour-Mousavi, the NIGC's director for gas supply, announced the company's plan for investing four billion dollars in smartening programs within the next four years. "In order to optimize gas consumption, a four-year project has been planned for smartening the network with an investment of four billion dollars," he said.

According to the official, there are currently 27 million gas meters active on the country's gas network whose smartening is on the agenda.

فرمانده یگان حفاظت اراضی استان اصفهان گفت: با تلاش مجموعه فرماندهی یگان حفاظت اراضی استان اصفهان و اجرای طرح‌های تشدید حفاظت اراضی ملی و دولتی استان منجر به ایجاد امنیت پایدار در این حوزه به منظور حفظ بیت‌المال و کاهش جرم زمین خواری شده است. امیرسعید باقری فرمانده یگان حفاظت اراضی استان اصفهان با بیان اینکه اراضی تحت پوشش این فرماندهی در گستره ۲۸ شهرستان و ۱۰۸ شهر واقع شده‌اند، اظهار داشت: در راستای حفاظت از این اراضی اقدامات پیشگیرانه در سه بخش وضعی، اجتماعی و فرهنگی، بازدید و بازرسی از یگان‌های مستقر در شهرستان‌ها و آموزش انجام می‌شود. وی با تأکید بر اینکه به منظور جلوگیری از تصرف اراضی ملی و دولتی در سطح استان اصفهان، همواره اجرای اقدامات پیشگیرانه در اولویت این یگان قرار دارد، افزود: در شش ماه نخست سال جاری برای اطلاع‌رسانی با نصب ۱۰۴ تابلو، علائم هشدار دهنده و دیوار نویسی هشدارهای لازم اعلام شده تا مردم استان بدانند کدام اراضی مربوط به بیت‌المال است.

باقری با بیان اینکه امسال تاکنون میزان گشت‌زنی تیم‌های عملیاتی این یگان بیش از ۲۴ هزار ساعت بوده است، گفت: تیم‌های گشت و مراقبت یگان حفاظت اراضی در سراسر استان اصفهان به صورت پیمایش روزانه در حال گشت‌زنی برای رصد اراضی ملی و دولتی تحت پوشش هستند و در صورت مشاهده موارد مربوط به تصرف این اراضی اقدامات قانونی لازم‌الاجرام می‌دهند.

فرمانده یگان حفاظت اراضی استان اصفهان اعلام داد: سامانه ۱۶۵۶ این یگان به صورت شبانه‌روزی به منظور دریافت اخبار و اطلاعات مردمی در ارتباط با تصرف اراضی ملی و دولتی فعال است. در نیمه نخست سال جاری نیز ۴۵ گزارش از طریق این سامانه دریافت شد که مورد رسیدگی قرار گرفت.
