سرپرست اداره کل کار، تعاون و رفاه اجتماعی استان اصفهان گفت: صنایع استان اصفهان در حال حاضر با کمبود جدی اعتبار روبرو هستند

کامران کلانی مهابادی در نشست خبری که در آستانه هفته تعاون برگزار شد با بیان اینکه وزارت کار، تعاون و رفاه اجتماعی در چهار حوزه فعالیت دارد، اظهار داشت: روابط کار از مهم‌ترین فعالیت این نهاد است که در اصفهان شرایط ویژه‌ای در این زمینه داریم چرا که سال گذشته حدود ۲۹ هزار پرونده شکایت کاری بررسی شده است.

تشکیل ۹ هزار و ۶۸۷ پرونده شکایت کاری و کارفرمایی در اصفهان وی ادامه داد: از ابتدای امسال نیز ۹ هزار و ۶۸۷ پرونده شکایت کاری و کارفرمایی تشکیل و بررسی شده است، باید توجه داشت که این حجم آمار به دلیل نبود صیانت لازم از نیروی کار است. سرپرست اداره کل کار، تعاون و رفاه اجتماعی استان اصفهان با بیان اینکه آموزش کارگران و کارفرمایان را در دستور کار داریم، اضافه کرد: برای این امر استفاده از ظرفیت دانشگاه‌ها و مراکز آموزشی را در برنامه خود داریم. وی با بیان اینکه با راه‌اندازی سامانه جامعه کار پرونده‌های کاری و کارفرمایی به صورت الکترونیکی تشکیل می‌شود، ادامه داد: بیمه بیکاری نیز از زیرمجموعه‌های این سامانه است که در گام اول احراز هویت انجام می‌شود و در استان اصفهان تاکنون برای ۱۰ هزار نفر احراز هویت انجام شده و این روند ادامه دارد.

Iraq Says Gas Imports from Iran to Continue for Next 5 Years

Iraq's oil minister, Ihsan Abdul-Jabbar, said his country has plans underway to produce its own gas to meet domestic needs, but imports from Iran will continue for the next five years. Abdul-Jabbar was quoted Tuesday as saying that at least 80 percent of the gas projects in Iraq are already under implementation. But a halt to imports from Iran will come no sooner than five years from now. "We will not import gas by 2025," he told al-Iraqia TV in an interview, according to Press TV. Iraq is under pressure from the US to make itself less dependent on Iran's energy, but Iraqi leaders say the demand is a bar set too high given the Arab country's state of infrastructure which is still badly battered decades after the US invasion and sanctions and economic decline. US leaders were hoping to bring Iraq on board as Prime Minister Mustafa al-Kadhimi visited Washington last week. President Donald Trump said US companies were involved in many prospects in Iraq's oil business. Ahead of Kadhimi's visit, five US firms signed agreements with the Iraqi government aimed at boosting what the White House characterized as Iraq's energy independence from Iran.

Cargo ship carrying Indian sugar to Afghanistan arrives in Chabahar

The first cargo ship carrying Indian sugar for Afghanistan arrived in Iran's southeastern Chabahar Port, Director-general of Ports and Maritime Department of Sistan-Baluchestan Province Behrouz Aqaei said on Wednesday. This cargo that carries 1,890 tons of Indian private sector's sugar in 70 containers docked at Shahid Beheshti port in Chabahar, said Behrouz Aqaei in an interview with IRNA. Last week on Wednesday, the seventh cargo ship carrying Indian donated wheat for Afghanistan with 352 containers whose consignment weighed about 8,800 tons, docked at Shahid Beheshti port in southeastern Iran. Aghaei added that some 1,700 containers weighing 43,000 tons of India's donated wheat for Afghanistan have so far arrived in Chabahar Port. Chabahar, as Iran's only ocean port, plays an important role in developing trade, exports, and imports and in fishing as well. Supreme Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei's special attention and the efforts made by President Hassan Rouhani's government have accelerated development of Makran Coasts, especially Chabahar Port, in a way that five big ships carrying basic goods, including wheat, barley, soybean, and corn berthed in one week. In 2016, Iran, India, and Afghanistan decided to jointly establish a trade route for land-locked Central Asian countries. India sent its first consignment of wheat to Afghanistan through Iran's Chabahar Port back in 2017.

Iran's Trade With Oman Burgeoning

A total of \$110 million worth of commodities were exported to Oman during the first four months of the current Iranian year (March 20-July 21), according to the secretary of Oman Affairs Bureau with the Trade Promotion Organization of Iran. "Our main exported products were construction materials and equipment, wooden and plastic artifacts, fruit and vegetables, red meat and chicken, food products, machinery parts, lead and copper," Soheila Rasoulnejad was also quoted as saying by ILNA. Oman is a southern neighbor of Iran located on the southern side of the Sea of Oman. Referring to shipping routes between Iranian ports of Jask, Shahid Bahonar, Shahid Rajaee and Khorramshahr and the Omani ports of Al Suwaiq, Shinas, Sohar and Sultan Qaboos Port, Chairman of Iran-Oman Chamber of Commerce Mohsen Zarrabi recently said, "Almost all countries closed their borders with Iran following the spread of the new coronavirus. However, Oman increased its shipping lines with Iranian ports to reduce the transportation costs of its imports."

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Iran's annual agricultural output expected to hit 130m tons by Mar. 2021

Iran's agricultural production is expected to reach 130 million tons in the current Iranian calendar year (March-2020-March 2021), according to the Agriculture Minister Kazem Khavazi.



Speaking in a meeting with some officials from Golestan Province, Khavazi put the country's agricultural

production in the previous Iranian calendar year (ended on March 19) at 125 million tons, IRNA reported. "This year, the government is paying special attention to the agricultural sector for achieving self-sufficiency in most agricultural and strategic products," the official said. He noted that apart from increasing production, the Agriculture Ministry also seeks to increase productivity by developing processing industries in this sector. The minister pointed to the sales of raw materials as important damage to the agricultural sector and said: "Currently,

The Agriculture Minister visited the northern Golestan Province for inaugurating some agricultural projects on Tuesday. In late June, the Acting Head of Agriculture Ministry's Economic Affairs Department Shahrokh Shajari had said that development of new

irrigation systems and greenhouses to improve water productivity, development of aquaculture, especially shrimp and fish farming at sea, and development of medicinal plants cultivation are among the plans underway by the ministry for increasing productivity in the agricultural sectors. Noting that one of the major indicators of the development of the agricultural sector is the value-added, the official said in most years, the growth of value-added in the agricultural sector has been more than the growth of the country's

non-oil Gross Domestic Products (GDP). "The value-added growth of the agricultural sector last year was 8.8 percent, despite the negative growth of the domestic value-added," he said. According to Shajari, production of grains reached 83.5 million tons in the previous year and the figure is expected to reach 86 million tons in the current year. As for the horticulture sector, the production of this sector reached 23 million tons in the past year and the output is expected to increase by 1.7 million tons in the current year.

2 new pharmaceutical factories to be inaugurated next week

Mohammad Reza Shanehsaz, head of Food and Drug Administration announced on Wednesday that two new pharmaceutical factories are to be inaugurated in the country next week. "Next week, two new pharmaceutical factories, one producing insulin pens and the other producing plasma products, will be inaugurated for the first time in the country in a ceremony attended

by the health minister," Shanehsaz said addressing a press conference held on the occasion of the birthday of Muhammad ibn Zakariya al-Razi which is marked as Iran's National pharmaceutical Day. He noted that although a definite medicine has not been discovered to treat Covid-19, any medicine that is effective in treating this disease has been produced in a short period of time in the country and even their raw materials have been produced domestically. Shanehsaz reiterated that Iran produces 97 percent of its required medicine domestically. He further explained that the remained three percent are always the medicines that are regularly introduced to the world drug network,

and we will be able to produce these medicine domestically over a period of time. "Now we claim that the Iranian pharmacists can produce any new drug that is manufactured in the world within two years," he said, "We are even able to manufacture its raw materials domestically." Despite western countries' sabotages in supplying Iran's needed medicine, today 97 percent of the medicine produced domestically. According to Iranian health officials, the country has achieved significant capabilities in producing medicine, its formulation, pharmaceutical knowledge and even the supply of domestic raw materials.

Iran to mass-produce COVID19-rapid diagnostic device

Secretary of Iran Nanotechnology Initiative Council, Saeed Sarkar said on Monday that Iran will mass-produce a rapid diagnostic device that can be used in public places such as airports. He made the remarks on Monday, noting that the device has been devised domestically by a researcher at Tehran University. "The device has obtained necessary licenses from Tehran University of Medical Sciences, on behalf of the Ministry of Health, and was able to perform clinical

tests with the cooperation of specialized teams in the fields of radiology, ICU, virology, and infectious diseases specialists," he added. According to Sarkar, the rapid diagnostic device has received written approval from the experts of the field and an article has also been published in this regard. He went on to say that the device is able to detect the symptoms of the disease within 30 minutes using a technique to evaluate the level of oxygen in the body.

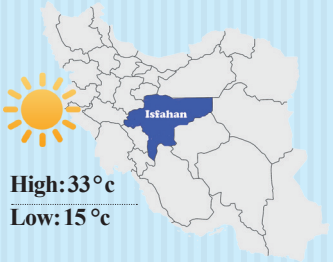

UNSC president: US snapback bid not effective

Indonesian Ambassador to UN and the current president of the UN Security Council, Dian Triansyah Djani, said on Tuesday the Security Council was "not in the position to take further action" on the US snapback bid against Iran.

President of the UN Security Council, Dian Triansyah Djani said on Tuesday that there is no consensus in the 15-member Security Council on the US bid to return all UN sanctions on Iran.

Indonesia's UN Ambassador Dian Triansyah Djani was responding to a question from Russia and China on the issue during a meeting on the Middle East.

Russia's UN Ambassador thanks Ambassador Djani for this conclusion. The meeting was adjourned as the UNSC gathers privately

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German expert describes US, Israel as today's oppressors

Referring to Imam Hussein's uprising against the oppressor ruler of his time, Dr. Markus Fiedler described the US and Zionist regime as two oppressors of today's world.

Every year, the freedom-lovers of the world keep the memory of Imam Hussein alive in the month of Muharram. Why is the uprising of Imam Hussein still dynamic despite the passage of many years?

The uprising of Imam Hussein and the positions of Islamic liberation theology seem highly topical, as the injustice in the world is becoming increasingly acute for everyone. According to an Oxfam report two years ago, 8 billionaires now own more than half of humanity, and the gap between rich and poor is widening. To a certain extent, he refutes the words of Karl Marx that religion is ultimately only "opium for the people". It shows that people - because of their religious convictions - oppose unjust conditions without simply putting people off to the hereafter.

In his uprising, Imam Hussein sacrificed his position, wealth and even his own family to fight against the oppressive ruler. What are the guidelines and messages of his uprising for the popular uprisings in the contemporary time?

The uprising of Imam Hussein shows that one should not allow oneself to be intimidated, even in the face of the apparently enormous superiority of the oppressors' camp. In the course of history, all great empires, however invincible in their time, have perished. There are timeless truths. Whoever hurls the truth at the oppressor - or whatever empire - and is not ready to raise the white flag, shows courage and steadfastness. Since it is a fight for a just cause, one knows according to all world religions that sovereignty is, so to speak, the basis of human dignity. It is undignified to crawl before oppressive powers.

Imam Hussein fought against Yazid to institutionalize the message of freedom and resistance to oppression. In your opinion, who

are the oppressors of today's world?

It is actually clear who is acting as an occupying power in Palestine, driving out the native population, treating it as second-class people and occupying foreign land. On a global scale there is only one military superpower today that maintains over 700 military bases in foreign countries. It threatens the few sovereign states in the world, tries to destabilize them and carry out a "regime change" there. Overturns and various "color revolutions" are staged. Instead of a democracy, however, such a regime change means the loss of sovereignty.

A distinction must be made between the American people and the ruling elite; the "establishment" is now also hated by broad sections of the US population. The US is really an oligarchy, not a democracy. This is not mine; it is the result of studies in the United States - one of which is that of political scientists Martin Gilens (Princeton) and Benjamin Page (Northwestern University).

According to the political scientist Jeffrey Winters who teaches at Northwestern University in Illinois, the super-rich controls politics and the media in the USA with their money. According to Winters, the super-rich only make up a tenth of one percent of the US population, i.e. 300,00 people. Today the financial elite is decisive. Around 1,000 trillion dollars are invested in derivatives that US investor Warren Buffet calls "financial weapons of mass destruction".

The tendencies towards resignation in societies must be countered. Instead, people need to be educated about Western propaganda. As I said before: Today one can learn from this not to despair, even in the face of the apparently gigantic superiority of the oppressors' camp. As we can see, given the events of our day (corona crisis, race riot in the US, economic crisis, etc.), the situation can change completely in a short period of time. It is not the person who determines the fate of the world. God also has His plan - and this will ultimately prevail.

What can today's freedom-seekers movements, including the anti-racist movement in countries like the United States, learn from this uprising?

UAE to Be Held Accountable for Any Israeli Threat to Iran: Spokesman

The Iranian administration's spokesperson censured the UAE for the strategic mistake of normalizing ties with the Zionist regime, reminding Abu Dhabi that it has to accept responsibility for any anti-Iranian move by Israel.

"We cannot remain indifferent to anti-security measures of our Zionist enemy near our borders," he emphasized.

Speaking to reporters at a weekly press conference on Tuesday, Ali Rabiee slammed the UAE's decision to formalize relations with the "usurping Zionist regime as a big and strategic mistake".

"We expect the UAE government officials to monitor the (Zionist) regime's activities inside their country and prevent any anti-security measure by the (Israeli) regime. The responsibility for any action against and its consequences for the Islamic Republic of Iran that would be taken by the Zionist regime will certainly lie with Abu Dhabi as well," he warned.

"We deem any dangerous interference from the Zionist regime in the region to be risky. We warn that the consequences of these measures would plague those countries themselves," the spokesman added.

He further reminded the Abu Dhabi officials that normalization of ties with Israel would "result in nothing but loss to those statesmen themselves." "It will become clear in the medium term that all of these will be detrimental (to the UAE)," he noted,

the government's website reported.

"The Zionist regime should be held accountable for the consequences of growing acts of interference. People of the region are definitely vigilant in this issue," Rabiee said.

"We cannot remain indifferent to anti-security measures of our Zionist enemy near our borders," he emphasized.

"All of our officials adopted stances. The Islamic Republic of Iran strongly condemns any attempt to establish formal and diplomatic relations with a fake regime. The normalization of ties with the Zionist regime is tantamount to support for the whole various crimes that Zionists have committed against people throughout history, during the past decades after their illegitimate formation, the crimes they have committed again people of the region, and the many wars they have imposed on the regional people and on the causes of the oppressed Palestinian nation," the spokesman added.

"Undoubtedly, the Muslim nations in the region have become growingly aware of the hidden aspects of the minds of leaders who have betrayed the issue of Palestine with their raw ideas and have given in to the Israeli desires. Its evidence is now obvious among the nations," the Iranian spokesperson concluded.

UNSC displayed US isolation again: Iran UN Mission

Stating that the US objective is to destroy Resolution 2231 and the JCPOA, Iran's Permanent Mission to the United Nations said that the deliberations in the UN Security Council showed the US isolation once again. Indonesian Ambassador to UN and the current president of the UN Security Council, Dian Triansyah Djani, said on Tuesday the Security Council was "not in the position to take further action" on the US snapback bid against Iran. His remarks came as the

US Secretary of State Mike Pompeo said on Friday that Washington delivered a letter to the UN for snapback invocation against Iran to bring back sanctions in 30 days. The full text of the statement released by Iranian mission in UN is as follows: Today, the overwhelming majority of the Security Council members rejected once again the admissibility of the recent letter by the United States to purportedly initiate a process to re-impose Security Council sanctions on Iran. Through individual or joint letters addressed to the Council's President, 13 out of 15 members of the Security Council -- including remaining participant States of the Joint Comprehensive

Plan of Action (JCPOA) -- as well as Iran have already strongly refuted the legal merit of the US letter. The Council members have made it clear that, the US, following its withdrawal from the JCPOA, is not a "JCPOA participant" anymore and as such has no right to initiate a process to re-impose Security Council sanctions on Iran as this right has been reserved only for "the JCPOA participant States". They believe that the US has forfeited its right to initiate a process to re-impose Security Council sanctions on Iran, and accordingly, its letter cannot be considered as the qualified notification for the purpose of Resolution 2231, thus is void of any legal effect now and in future.
