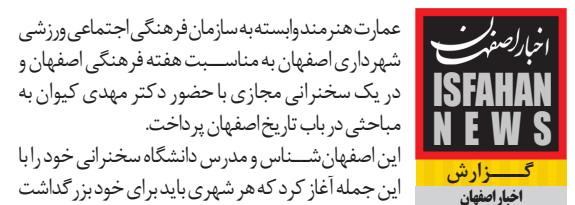

این اصفهانی شناس با بیان اینکه اصفحانی بودن یک مسئولیت است، افزود: امروز ما از لایه لایه شدن خود به نسل جوان که دچار نومیدی است، همدار و اندازدهم که اصفهان شهری مورد توجه و محترم بوده و ادبیات ما از ستایش این شهر پر است.

کیوان انقلاب مشروطیت در سال ۱۲۸۵ شمسی را یکی از نقاط عطف تاریخ اصفهان دانست و درباره زایش و پالش مدنیت مدرن در اصفهان از ۱۲۸۵ تا ۱۳۵۷ گفت: لایه و قشری که در دوره مشروطیت به متورالفکر معروف بودند که در دوره رضاشاه به آنها روشن فکر گفته می شد، باید در جامعه صاحب اثر باشند چون مردم به راهنمایی نیاز دارند. قشری به نام متورالفکر و روشن فکر متولد شد که مدنیتی را قبول دارند که پس از شکست ایران در ترکمنچای با آن برخورد می کنیم، چون آن زمان متوجه شدیم که تاریخ اروپا ورق خورده و ما عقب مانده ایم.

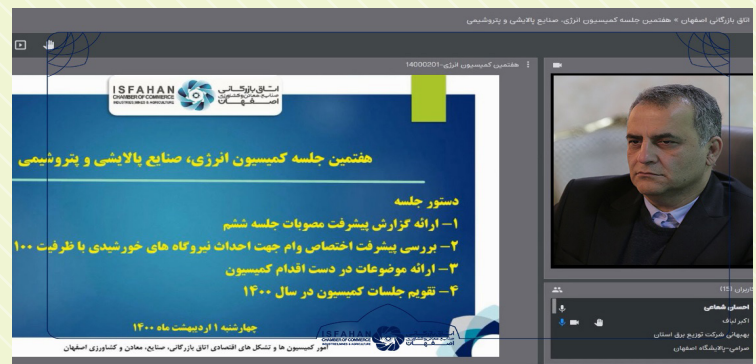

کمیسیون انرژی، صنایع پالایشی و پتروشیمی به بررسی پیشرفت اختصاص وام جهت احداث نیروگاه های خورشیدی با ظرفیت ۱۰۰ کیلووات اختصاص یافت.

در این جلسه اکبر لباف، نایب رئیس کمیسیون انرژی، مصرف حدود ۱۰ درصد گاز ۹ درصد برق کشور در استان اصفهان و وجود ۷ درصد ظرفیت نیروگاهی کشور در این استان را گویای این امر دانست که اصفهان استانی بزرگ در تولید و مصرف انرژی و محصولات انرژی بر است. وی افزود: از این رو استفاده از فرصت های موجود و پیش بینی چالش ها و کمک به رفع مشکلات پیش روی فعالان این حوزه ضروری است. عضو هیات نمایندگان اتاق بازرگانی اصفهان ابراز امیدواری نمود اقدامات کمیسیون انرژی نقش مهمی در گشایش مشکلات این حوزه و سرمایه گذاری در این زمینه ایفا نمایند. وی تهیه گزارش امکان سنجی اختصاص خوراک نفت خام به واحدهای دارای پتانسیل پالایشی و تبدیلی و انجام پیگیریها و هماهنگی های لازم با شرکت های توزیع برق استان و شهرستان برای احداث ۱۰ نیروگاه خورشیدی ۱۰۰ کیلوواتی برای واحدهای صنعتی را از جمله اقدامات سال گذشته کمیسیون عنوان کرد.

■ صدور ۱۲ موافقتنامه نصب سامانه نیروگاه خورشیدی

در ادامه سارا صالحی، مدیر دفتر بازاریار این شرکت توزیع برق اصفهان از بازدید برق شرکت از ۱۵۰۰ مگاواتی تراز انرژی استان اصفهان بدون در نظر گرفتن پیک امکان سنجی نصب نیروگاه ۱۰۰ کیلووات و در نهایت صدور ۱۲ موافقتنامه سامانه نیروگاه خورشیدی و معرفی آنها به بانک به منظور دریافت تسهیلات خبر داد. وی افزود: متأسفانه این فرایند از زمان معرفی متقاضی به بانک، تاکنون پیشرفت چندانی نداشته است و ابراز امیدواری کرد با بازنگری این فرایند و تعامل بیشتر بانک، اتفاق خوبی در این زمینه رقم بخورد.

■ توجیه پذیری اقتصادی پروژه های نصب نیروگاه خورشیدی ۱۰۰ کیلووات برای بانک

همچنین محمدرضا مدنی، نماینده بانک ملی، با بیان اینکه با توجه به محدود بودن منابع بانکی و وجود الزاماتی در بانک، مدیریت تخصیص منابع از اهمیت زیادی برخوردار است، افزود: در حال حاضر تمامی دغدغه شبکه بانکی معطوف به حمایت از مشاغل آسیب دیده از کرونا بوده است ولی با توجه به محرز شدن توجیه پذیری اقتصادی این طرح برای بانک، همکاری لازم را برای اجرایی شدن این پروژه خواهیم داشت. مدنی در ادامه موضوع تسهیلات تقاهم نامه سه جانبه میان بانک ملی، اتاق بازرگانی و شرکت توزیع برق اصفهان برای مشخص شدن روند کار برای متقاضیان و سرعت بخشی به اجرای این پروژه شد.

■ ضرورت فعالسازی نیروگاه های شرق و جنوب اصفهان

احمد رضا صافی، عضو کمیسیون انرژی اتاق اصفهان و رئیس سندیکای صنعت برق ایران نیز ضمن بیان منفی ۱۵۰۰ مگاواتی تراز انرژی استان اصفهان بدون در نظر گرفتن پیک مصرف در تابستان، گفت: در حال حاضر برخی از نیروگاه های استان خارج از مدار بوده و نیروگاه اصفهان نیز به دلیل کمبود آب با ۲۰ درصد ظرفیت مشغول کار است و به این ترتیب بر اساس پیش بینی های صورت گرفته، شبکه برق استان در تابستان امسال وضعیت خوبی نخواهد داشت و لازم است هر چه سریعتر پروژه های احداث نیروگاه شرق اصفهان و واحد سیکل ترکیبی نیروگاه جنوب اصفهان فعالسازی شوند.

سعید محسنی، مدیر عامل شرکت تولید

نیروی برق اصفهان، منفی بودن تراز تولید برق در مقایسه با مصرف در استان اصفهان، عدم تمایل بخش خصوصی به احداث نیروگاه در شرایط فعلی، زمان بر بودن پروسه راه اندازی نیروگاه و کمبود آب مورد نیاز برای نیروگاه ها را از جمله مشکلات منطقه اصفهان دانست که در این زمینه استفاده از پساب تصفیه شده برای تأمین آب مورد نیاز نیروگاه ها به عنوان یک راهکار مطرح شد. وی همچنین از طرح ضرورت فعالسازی نیروگاه شرق و واحد سیکل ترکیبی نیروگاه جنوب استان و پیگیری موضوع توسط مسئولین از وزارت نیرو خبر داد. مدنی همچنین بر ضرورت رعایت صرفه جویی در مصرف آب و برق و اعمال مدیریت بار به صنایع بزرگ و پیاده سازی دقیق برنامه های مدیریت مصرف از هم اکنون تأکید کرد.

■ الزام تأمین برق مشترکین بر مصرف از طریق بورس یا قرار دادهای دوجانبه نیروگاهی در ادامه پروین بهبهانی، کارشناس شرکت توزیع برق استان نیز گفت: طبق مصوبه وزارت نیرو از ابتدای اردیبهشت ماه جاری کلیه مشترکین با دیامند بالای ۵ مگاوات الزاماً باید برق مصرفی مورد نیاز خود را از طریق بورس یا قرار دادهای دوجانبه با نیروگاه ها تأمین کنند که این امر در صورت انجام خرید منطقی، هزینه های حساب نهایی مشترکین را کاهش خواهد داد. در ادامه این جلسه ضمن بیان این نکته که پارامتر قیمت برق دغدغه ای برای مصرف کننده و تولید کننده است بر ضرورت اصلاح بهای انرژی در کشور و همچنین انجام مطالعات دقیق در خصوص اینکه آیا با توجه به مسائل زیست محیطی، توسعه نیروگاه های حرارتی امری به صرفه است یا خیر، تأکید شد.

FDA head: Iran's medicine import reduced by 29%

Head of Iran's Food and Drug Administration said that Iran's import in medicine and medical equipment had reduced sharply due to the importance of local production in the last two years.

Attending a press conference on Saturday morning in Tehran, Mohammadreza Shanehsaz highlighted the pressure imposed on Iran due to sanctions, adding that Food and Drug Administration (FDA) made its efforts to create opportunities and decrease imports significantly.

Referring to the remarks of the Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Sayyed Ali Khamenei about focusing on local production, Shanehsaz noted that domestic companies had taken effective steps, and the indigenous production increased up to 92% in various areas.

Regarding the coronavirus pandemic, FDA's head added: "We knew that our enemies would cause trouble for us, so we focused on domestic production and produced all the necessary medicine in less than three months."

Mohammadreza Shanehsaz referred to Iran's mass production of coronavirus vaccine in June, expressing hope that all Iranians would be vaccinated by the end of the 1400 Iranian year (March 20, 2022).

FDA's head pointed to the unfair distribution of coronavirus vaccine across the world, stressing that Iran did its best to pay for COVAX but did not receive the expected supply.

Although the coronavirus vaccine is in the government's hands, Iran welcomes any private company which can import it.

Until now, 49 companies have expressed readiness to import the vaccine, and 35 introduction documents were issued for that, but yet none of them could take major steps, Shanehsaz concluded.

Iran bans entry from eastern borders

Iran's Customs spokesman, Rouhollah Latifi, said on Friday that entering the country from the eastern borders for the citizens of Afghanistan, Pakistan and other countries was prohibited due to the coronavirus conditions.

Latifi said that the ban was put in place on Wednesday for Pakistani citizens and Afghan nationals and citizens of other countries were banned from entering the country on Thursday.

Citizens of Pakistan and Afghanistan normally entered Iran from border crossings of Mirjaveh, Rimdan, Milak, Mahiroud and Dogharoun on the eastern borders.

He said that because of a delay in informing border guard entities of new coronavirus-related restrictions, 192 people crossed Mirjaveh and Rimdan border on Tuesday. Iran has taken precautionary measures to prevent the new Indian variant of the coronavirus from entering the country.

The country is already struggling with the fourth wave of COVID-19 pandemic with the daily number of deaths touching 496 cases on Monday.

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Russia obliges US to release Iran's frozen assets

The head of the Russian Delegation in the JCPOA talks, while expressing hope over the progress of talks in Vienna, reiterated that the present time would be the best time US to take the first step regarding JCPOA and release Iran's frozen assets.



Mikhail Ulyanov made the remarks in an interview with the French newspaper Le Monde, adding

that the United States had created many problems in implementing the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action by withdrawing from it and imposing maximum pressure on Iran.

He noted that he met with Robert Malley, the US special envoy for Iran, within the framework of a bilateral meeting in Vienna yesterday (On Thursday), reiterating that there is no reason for the United States to block Iranian assets in South Korea and Japan.

Referring to the fact that Iran's properties do not belong to the



United States, the senior Russian diplomat added that blocking them by Washington was illegal and the present time would be the best time for the Biden administration to release them in good faith.

During Donald Trump's tenure, Washington unilaterally imposed economic terrorism to put maximum pressure on the Iranian people. Two years after the European parties' procrastination in fulfilling their obligations under the JCPOA, Iran began to take steps in scaling back its

commitment under the agreement.

Tehran announced that if the obligations of the other parties to the agreement were fulfilled, it would benefit from its interests under the nuclear deal. It will return to the full implementation of its obligations.

The new US president has criticized the White House's previous policy toward Iran but said his return to the JCPOA was conditional on Iran's action. Without mentioning which government had promised and left the

deal, Biden allegedly promised that in Iran's return to full implementation of JCPOA, Washington would also return to this agreement. Meanwhile, representatives of the JCPOA member states have been meeting in Vienna for the past three weeks to discuss activating the agreement and the possible return of the United States to it. They have so far convened several meetings of the Joint Commission in Vienna and made progress reviving the nuclear deal.

JCPOA paves way for int'l economic activities

The JCPOA affected the country's economy, changed the global attitude towards Iran's nuclear activities and prepared the grounds for international economic activities, the former official said.

In an exclusive interview with IRNA, former deputy of Isfahan governor for political, security and social affairs Seyyed Reza Aghdaei said the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA) with European and American countries was one of the government's key measures to overcome difficult situation and confidence building for

the government.

Verification of the international organizations to explain the peaceful exploitation of Iran's nuclear program was the outcome of JCPOA.

Referring to the potential of Western and European international relations, he said, Establishing proper relations with Western countries will help strengthen Iran's infrastructure.

Countries like Japan, South Korea, Malaysia and Indonesia which reinforced their international relations, have never been colonized or harmed, Aghdaei noted.

He described JCPOA as effective in improving relations between Iran and the Arab states in the region, saying this opportunity should be provided

for communication with the regional countries.

Trump's inefficient and inexperienced management in the United States and the totalitarian forces inside the country which were the businessmen of the sanctions prevented the full implementation of this international event.

Elsewhere in his remarks, Aghdaei termed the international interactions as an opportunity for the country.

Enemies and governments that consider the relationship between Iran and the world as a threat to their interests, instill military and nuclear activities as a threat to the world by creating pessimism among other countries.

Exports from Shahid Rajaei port grow by 59 percent

Hormozgan Ports and Maritime head said on Saturday that Shahid Rajaei port in the Persian Gulf province saw 59 percent growth in exports and 160 percent in transit last month. Alireza Mohammadi Karajiran said that in the first month of the Iranian calendar (March 21-April 20) 158 container ships docked and 126,850 TEU containers were loaded and unloaded in the port, showing 12 percent increase compared to the same period last year. He also said that TEU containers transit experienced 160 percent increase in this period compared to the last year with 20,231 TEUs transmitted. Shahid Rajaei port is located in Hormozgan Province, south Iran and enjoys 30 gantry cranes and 15 exclusive wharves. It is considered the largest container port in Iran.

Imports of vaccine is not forbidden like weapon; Official

Chairman of Iran-China Chamber of Commerce and Industries says China has given Iran some 850,000 doses of COVID-19 vaccines for free, reiterating that Iran's Ambassador to Beijing is trying hard to provide more vaccines.

Speaking to ILNA, Majid-Reza Hariri said that China has given Iran 850,000 doses of COVID-19 vaccines for free as humanitarian aids. Reacting to why the names of the companies in charge of importing vaccine is not forbidden like weapon that the names of the importing companies are kept secret and the companies are just doing their social responsibility and for this reason perhaps they do not like their names to be announced.

He noted that the chamber is not opposed to imports of vaccines by the private sector and there is no doubt about it but regarding vaccination, there should be some priorities in order to reduce the death toll in the country.

Majid-Hariri went on to say that Iran's Ambassador to China is working hard to provide more vaccines for the country and so far he has achieved in dispatch of 850,000 doses of the COVID-19 vaccines to Iran which all have been for free. He reiterated that the price of Russian COVID-19 vaccines is more expensive than the Chinese one and the prices which are quoted in the country are not right. He reiterated that public health cannot be a tool for business and all should work for transparency especially by the private sector.

Next Major War Will Be 'Very Different,' US Defense Secretary Says

The United States needs to prepare for a potential future conflict bearing little resemblance to "the old wars" that have long consumed the Pentagon, Defense Secretary Lloyd Austin said Friday in his first significant policy speech.

Austin called for harnessing technological advances and better integrating military operations globally to "understand faster, decide faster and act faster."

"The way we fight the next major war is going to look very different from the way we fought the last ones," Austin said during a trip to the Hawaii-based US Pacific Command, Reuters reported.

Austin did not explicitly mention rivals like China or Russia. But his remarks came as the United States starts an unconditional withdrawal from Afghanistan on orders from President Joe Biden aimed at ending America's longest war and resetting Pentagon priorities.

Austin acknowledged that he has spent "most of the past two decades executing the last of the old wars."

Austin's remarks did not appear to prescribe specific actions or predict any specific conflict. He instead appeared to outline broad, somewhat vague goals to drive the Pentagon under the Biden administration.

"We can't predict the future," Austin said. "So what we need is the right mix of technology, operational concepts and capabilities - all woven together in a networked way that is so credible, so flexible and so formidable that it will give any adversary pause."

Preventing a conflict would mean creating "advantages for us and dilemmas for them," he said. US responses could be indirect, he said, outlining a scenario in which cyber warfare could be used "to respond to a maritime security incident hundreds of miles away."

Russia Never Threatened Anyone with Sanctions, Spokeswoman Says

Russia has never threatened anyone with its response sanctions, Foreign Ministry Spokeswoman Maria Zakharova said on her Facebook page, commenting on the remark of President of the European Parliament David Sassoli, who was earlier banned from entering Russia. Earlier on Friday, the Russian Foreign Ministry published a statement listing eight EU citizens who are banned from entering Russian territory. Besides Sassoli, the list includes Berlin chief prosecutor Jorg Raupach, Head of the CBRN Protection and Security Division at the Swedish Defense Research Agency Asa Scott, and Vice President of the European Commission for Values and Transparency Vera Jourova, TASS reported. The measure was taken in response to the European Council's sanctions against six Russian nationals of March 2 and 22, 2021. In response to Moscow's decision, Sassoli stated on Twitter: "No sanctions or intimidation will stop the (European Parliament) or me from defending human rights, freedom, and democracy."

Recognition of Israel as an apartheid regime

Despite continued disregard for Israeli crimes, Human Rights Watch has finally acknowledged the regime's racism and institutionalized discrimination and issued a report calling for the International Criminal Court to intervene.

"After years of warning that such domination of Palestinian life could lead to apartheid, it is now clear that Israel has crossed all human borders and entered the valley of apartheid and racial discrimination," the report said.

In an interview with the British Guardian newspaper, the director of West Asia at Human Rights Watch admitted that the organization had never accused Israeli authorities of crimes against humanity in the past 30 years, but that there was "indisputable evidence" of apartheid against seven million Palestinians.

The report of Human Rights Watch, which officially describes Israel as an apartheid regime, confirms the Islamic Republic of Iran's persistent view that the Zionist regime is racist. The term "apartheid" means racial superiority and the superiority of one race over another, and apartheid regimes often defend their racist interests through war, terror, and violence. By distorting the foundations of the religion of Prophet Moses, the racists of Zionism consider the Jews as the chosen nation of God and the supreme race, and encourage them to confront the Muslim Palestinians. According to this belief, the Zionist regime considers the coexistence of Jews and non-Jews in one land as distasteful and impossible.

The Israeli regime considers the forced expulsion of the Palestinian people from their homeland as a strategy and seeks to expel the Muslims from their ancestral homeland by putting pressure on Muslims and expanding Zionist settlements. Israeli leaders see the growing Palestinian population as a threat to their very existence and seek to restrict Palestinians from reproducing and increase their population in various initiatives, including the Great Deal of the Century.

The conviction of Western institutions, such as Human Rights Watch, of the institutionalization of apartheid in the occupied territories is a clear indication of the common destiny of the Zionist regime with the apartheid regime in South Africa. South Africa survived the apartheid regime under the United States, Britain, Canada, Australia, and parts of Europe and never imagined its downfall. The roots of racism go back to two centuries before Nelson Mandela was born, and the collapse of apartheid and the victory of blacks were far from expected.

But with the continuation of the anti-apartheid struggle and the support of the international community

for these struggles, the racists were defeated and today blacks and whites live together and witness the progress of their country. There is no doubt that the apartheid regime in Israel is following the same path as the racists in South Africa, and that the struggle of the Palestinian people with the support of the Axis of Resistance will make the collapse of Zionism possible. Ayatollah Khamenei The Leader of the Islamic Revolution on December 15, 2016, during a meeting with the Secretary General of the Palestinian Islamic Jihad Movement, predicted the collapse of the Zionist regime and noted that "despite the constant crisis created by the supporters of the Zionist regime to forget the issue of Palestine, this honorable land will be liberated thanks to the resistance and struggle of the Palestinian people and groups." In recent years, the brutal and inhumane actions of Netanyahu, the Prime Minister of the Zionist regime, and Also, the arrogant policies

of the United States during the Trump era, such as the great deal of the century, the relocation of the US embassy to Jerusalem, and the recognition of Zionist rule in the Golan Heights, have backfired and raised hopes for the collapse of Israel.

The influx of large numbers of Jewish investors into Patagonia, a fertile area on the Chilean-Argentine border and the purchase of land there for Jewish settlements, is seen by Israeli leaders as a prospect of the regime's collapse.

The current situation in Israel and the unstable situation of Netanyahu after the failure of the elections and summoning him to court due to widespread financial corruption, along with the constant struggle of the oppressed Palestinian people and the axis of resistance, against the corrupt Zionist regime show a clear destiny for this regime. The collapse of apartheid is predictable.

The fall of the racist regime in South Africa was made possible by a popular referendum after a long struggle, and the Palestinian people and the people of the Occupied Territories must soon prepare for a referendum to determine the governing system of the land.

Americans' signatures not to guarantee sanctions removal

Signatures of US officials are no longer enough to guarantee to lift of the sanctions, an Iranian lawmaker said, adding, "We need to verify to make sure that the sanctions are completely lifted by the United States." Joe Biden, like Donald Trump, has realized that sanctions on Iran had reached a dead end, a member of Parliament's National Security and Foreign Policy Commission said, while speaking in an interview with Mehr News Agency. Washington resorted to all tools to impose pressure on Iran, Vahid Jalal Zadeh said, adding, "However, when the Americans witnessed the resistance of the Iranian nation against sanctions, they gradually decided to retreat from this tactic and return to JCPOA." He went on to say, "We welcome the return of the United States to JCPOA as well as the complete lifting of sanctions, however we are in no hurry; first of all, everything must be verified." Elsewhere in his remarks, he stressed that the signatures of US officials are no longer enough to guarantee the lifting of the sanctions.



US to call for Nord Stream 2 project closure: report

The US Secretary of State is expected to call for the closure of the Nord Stream 2 pipeline project. Acting Assistant Secretary of State in the Bureau of European and Eurasian Affairs Philip Reeker said on Friday that US Antony Blinken is to do that during an upcoming meeting with his German counterpart Heiko Maas, TASS reported. Reeker told reporters at a special briefing that the US and German top diplomats are to hold a bilateral meeting on the sidelines of the G7 ministerial meeting in London.

"I think that we will meet separately with the Germans in the bilateral format. Nord Stream 2 remains an issue. You heard that from the president, from the secretary, from the spokesmen. And we will continue to make it very clear to the Germans our views of that project, that it should stop," he said.

According to the US diplomat, many other issues will be raised during bilateral talks as well.

Washington openly opposes the Nord Stream 2 construction and is engaged in active efforts to halt the project to primarily deal a blow to Moscow's interests and provide support to Ukraine as a country that is used to transit Russia's natural gas to Europe. Moreover, many experts point out that the US is seeking to convince Europe to purchase its LNG which is much more expensive than the natural gas that Russia delivers via pipelines. In the past few years, the United States adopted a series of legislative acts that pave the way for unilateral sanctions, including on companies involved in the project.

The Nord Stream 2 project envisages the construction of two pipeline strings with a total capacity of 55 bln cubic meters per year from the coast of Russia through the Baltic Sea to Germany. The pipeline's construction was suspended at the end of 2019 when the Swiss pipe-laying company Allseas stopped work due to Washington's sanctions. However, work resumed in December 2020 after a year-long pause. The new pipeline will double the capacity of the Nord Stream pipeline currently in operation, following largely the same route.

Iran Police Disband Gang Selling American Guns

The Iranian Police forces have disbanded a gang of criminals involved in illegal online weapons trade, a commander said.

The deputy commander of the Iranian Police said the gun-running band was trading weapons in the virtual space.

The Police forces detected the gun-runners and captured all gang members in less than two weeks, General Qassem Rezaee said.

All weapons that the gang had put up for sale have been made in the United States and smuggled into Iran from Turkey, the general noted, adding that Turkey has been asked to take the necessary measures to stop arms smuggling into Iran.

Diplomat: We will not forget partners during sanctions

Iran will not forget its partners of difficult sanction era, Deputy Foreign Minister for Economic Affairs Rasoul Mohajer.

In an interview with IRNA, Mohajer said as the US withdrew from JCPOA, Foreign Minister Mohammad Javad Zarif changed the structure of the Foreign Ministry and formed the economic diplomacy department. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs has recently tried to reinforce its economic aspect, he added. While all Iranian banks are sanctioned, the ministry monitors the international situation and tries to pave the way for establishing interactions with other countries, Mohajer said. He stressed the importance of developing economic relations with neighbors, noting that the UAE is Iran's third economic partner that - despite political differences between the two countries - is offering Iran more stable conditions in bilateral relations than with Saudi Arabia. The US Administration and all American institutions are seeking to close all Iran's economic openings, the official added, stressing that the full-scale economic war is not an exaggeration.

In recent years, all Iranian banks and shipping companies have been sanctioned, and the Americans have tried to prevent Iranian ships from sailing, he went on to note. Referring to the growth of Iran's non-oil exports growth, the senior diplomat said that due to the outbreak of the coronavirus, numerous world countries are facing economic recession. Perhaps there are only a few countries whose economic growth was not negative since the pandemic, he said, adding that Iran's economy was not immune to the depression, while, in addition to the effects of the Corona pandemic and the subsequent wide closures, Iran's economy was grappling with harsh US sanctions that caused the country to stagnate. Iran tried to develop ties with neighbors and important countries such as China, India and Russia during the time, he said. The foreign ministry official went on to say that China with 26% of import and export share is Iran's first economic partner. The UAE and Afghanistan are the next importers of Iranian non-oil good, Mohajer noted. The Iran-China 25-year cooperation document is a symbol of balance in foreign



relations, he further reiterated. He described Iran as the most independent country in the world, saying even the United States is not independent and its policies depend on the Zionist regime. Iran's relations with European countries are smaller than with its neighbors "because Europe owes itself to US policies and has not even been able to develop its economic relations with Iran through the INSTEX mechanism."

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Iran, Afghanistan sign 2nd joint border MoU

At the end of the joint cooperation meeting between Sistan and Baluchestan of the Islamic Republic of Iran and Nimruz province of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan, the second memorandum of understanding was signed.

The agreement was signed by the Deputy Governor General for economic affairs of southeastern Iranian province of Sistan and Baluchestan, Mandana Zangeneh, and the Deputy Governor of the southwestern Afghan province of Nimruz, Abdolnabi Barahooei in Zaranj, according to the Saturday report of public relations office of Sistan and Baluchestan governor general office. "Improving the livelihoods of border residents of both sides is one of the most important effects of the joint border of Sistan and Baluchestan of Iran and Nimruz province of Afghanistan," Zangeneh stressed.

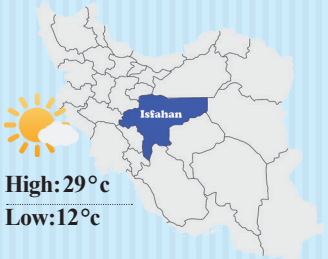

Diplomacy can help S Arabia, Iran de-escalate tensions: Analyst

Recent remarks made by Saudi Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman on his country's readiness to improve relations with the Islamic Republic of Iran show that the Arab state is serious to return to diplomacy in order to deescalate tensions with Tehran, a political expert believes.

Salman Safavi, chairman of the International Peace Studies Centre (IPSC), told E'temad newspaper on Saturday that concurrent with Iranian Foreign Minister Mohammad Javad Zarif's regional tour to four countries (Iraq, Kuwait, Qatar and Oman) to promote Hormuz Peace Initiative – proposed by the Iranian President Hassan Rouhani two and a half years ago – the Saudi crown prince expressed readiness to restore amicable ties with Iran. Safavi emphasized that regional and international conditions have been changed, noting that the resistance movement in Yemen has been relatively successful, the Biden administration is trying to come back to its commitments under the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA) and the policy of economic war against the Iranian nation bore no fruit for the United States and its allies; so, the world is changing its attitude towards the Islamic Republic.

Saudi Arabia has recently understood that pursuing the policy of hostility with Iran is doomed to failure; therefore, Riyadh plans to find a way to return to diplomacy in dealing with the Islamic country, the political expert said, adding that it is important that the Iranian officials should tell their Saudi counterpart

that the de-escalation of tensions between the US and Iran will not be against Saudis' interests. According to the London-based analyst, Saudi Arabia, the United Arab Emirates and Bahrain are expected to change their behavior with Iran. He added that understanding between Riyadh and Tehran will help create better relations with the UAE and Bahrain.

He further referred to the role of Iraq as a mediating country in unlocking relations between Saudi Arabia and Iran, adding that Mustafa al-Kadhimi, Iraqi Prime Minister is well aware that the improvement of ties between Riyadh and Tehran will enhance national security in Iraq.

As to Saudi war on Yemen, the expert noted that the United States and Britain want Riyadh to stop killing civilians in the war-torn country, and that there is no sign of victory for the Saudis and Emiratis in the long-term conflict. Safavi urged the Iranian authorities to play the role of an elder brother in the Persian Gulf region and call on the regional states to strengthen security and develop cooperation based on their own collective might and stop depending on the Western powers.

Pointing to controversies around release of Zarif's comments inside Iran, while the top diplomat was busy to pursue improvement of ties with regional nations, Safavi argued that Dr. Zarif and honorable Martyr Qassem Soleimani had an amicable ties and they were cooperating; although, expertise disagreement between two officials is completely natural. He also urged the Iranians not to allow enemies to distort achievements in both diplomacy and field.

He further referred to the role of Iraq as a mediating country in unlocking relations between Saudi Arabia and Iran, adding that Mustafa al-Kadhimi, Iraqi Prime Minister is well aware that the improvement of ties between Riyadh and Tehran will enhance national security in Iraq.

Saudi envoy's official UK residence targeted by arsonists

The Saudi Ambassador's official London residence was targeted by arsonists today who set fire to the front of the multi-million-pound building before police arrested two men after a struggle. A witness told

MailOnline two middle-aged men who had been 'loitering around' the property on Kensington Palace Gardens approached it at around 1.40 pm before one threw an object over the gate, setting alight to several bushes. A security guard then rushed out to confront the men and was punched in the face and left with an injured eye. Police rushed to the

scene and were seen handcuffing two men before loading them into a van. One fire engine arrived and put out the blaze after 10 minutes. The Met said one man was arrested for arson and a second for assault. A third man who was standing nearby was found to be in possession of Class A drugs and arrested. It is not clear if he was involved in the attack on the building.

Normalization of ties with Zionist regime against spirit of Ummah: Speakers

Iranian and Pakistani speakers emphasizing to resist any conspiracy to downplay the issue of Palestine among Muslims say normalizing of ties with the Zionist regime is against the principle of unity of the Islamic world.

They expressed the views at a webinar in connection with the international day of Al-Quds organized by the Iranian Cultural Center in the southern city of Karachi.

Sayed Mohammad Reza Sajjadi, Acting Consul General of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Karachi, Bahram Kian, Head of Iranian Cultural Center as well as a number of prominent Pakistani figures affiliated with political parties, media Religious groups, and officials participated in the webinar.

Bahram Kian, Head of Iranian Cultural Center said Al-Quds Day is an intelligent initiative of Imam Khomeini (RA), which had given a new soul to the issue of Palestine.

He added Holy Quds, as the first Qibla of Muslims, is a component that evaluates the identity and credibility of the Muslims of the world.

"The issue of Palestine remains the first issue of the Islamic world and the support of the Palestinian cause and Holy Quds, is a link between Muslims around the world," he said.

He added we are now witnessing events in some Islamic countries that have targeted the unity of Muslims and the Islamic Ummah.

He said normalization of relations with the fake, terrorist, and usurper Zionist regime have created divisions among the Islamic Ummah.

Bahram Kian emphasized normalization of ties with the usurper Zionist regime is a clear betrayal of the aspirations of the oppressed people of Palestine.

He referred to the Supreme Leader's statement that Palestine belongs to the Palestinians and must be governed by their will.

Sayed Mohammad Reza Sajjadi, Acting Consul General of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Karachi expressing his views said Quds Day this year is different from every year; because it the first day of Al-Quds after the action of some Arab

****Unrest in Islamic countries, occupiers' attempt to weaken Palestine cause**

Dr. Shaista Tabassum head of the International Relations Department, University of Karachi said the illegitimate Zionist government was established in the Middle East more than seventy years ago with the help and cooperation of Western powers, and in a short time it is against all international laws.
