## OPEC+ calls off oil output talks after Saudi-UAE dispute

Saudi Arabia's energy minister Abdulaziz bin Salman had called for compromise and rationality to secure a deal after two days of failed discussions last week, according to Reuters.

But four OPEC+ sources said there had been no progress. OPEC's Secretary-General Mohammad Barkindo said in a statement on Monday that the meeting had been canceled, without a date for the next one being agreed. The failure of the talks, which had partly been about an increase in oil output from next month, helped to drive up international benchmark Brent crude, which was trading 1.1% higher at above \$77 a barrel.

Some OPEC+ sources said there would be no oil output increase in August, while others said a new meeting would occur in the coming days, and they believed there would be a boost in August.

"There is no decision about August and discussions still continue. The market needs that oil," one source familiar with the talks said.

Oil prices are at the highest since 2018 and have already prompted concerns that inflation could derail a global recovery from the pandemic.

OPEC+ agreed on record output cuts of almost 10 million barrels per day (bpd) last year, about 10% of world output, as the pandemic hit. The curbs have been gradually relaxed and stand at about 5.8 million bpd.

Sources said: "The UAE on Friday accepted a proposal from Saudi Arabia and other OPEC+ members to raise output in stages by about 2 million bpd from August to December but rejected extending remaining cuts to the end of 2022 from the current end date of April without adjusting its current baseline production."

The UAE is upset about the low baseline from which its production cuts are calculated and wants it raised. Abu Dhabi had invested billions of dollars in increasing its production capacity and says its baseline was set too low when OPEC+ initially forged its pact.

On Monday, OPEC+ sources said the UAE's position was unchanged. They told a ministerial panel chaired by Saudi Arabia and Russia, the Joint Ministerial Monitoring Committee needed more time to discuss the issue.

The UAE has said it was not alone seeking a higher baseline. Others, including Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kuwait, and Nigeria, had requested and received new ones since the deal was first agreed on last year.

The dispute reflects a growing divergence between Saudi Arabia and the UAE.

The public disagreement between the United Arab Emirates and Saudi Arabia over OPEC policy points to a growing economic rivalry between the two largest Arab economies, which only looks set to intensify.

## Talks under way for getting Iraqi visa for Iranian traders

The Vice Chairman of Iran-Iraq Joint Chamber of Commerce said that talks are under way for the facilitation of issuance of Iraqi visa for Iranian traders and businesspersons.

Speaking in an interview with IRNA on Tue., Shahla Omori pointed to the problems facing trade and business activity of the country for obtaining visa in order to do trade and business activities with Iraq and stated, "With the incessant follow-ups made, the commercial attaché of Iranian Embassy to Baghdad put the facilitation of issuance of visa special of Iranian businesspersons a top agenda."

Turning to her recent visit with Iranian commercial attaché in Baghdad, she reiterated that issuance of visa for Iranian traders for doing business and trade activity in Iraq was taken into serious consideration in this visit. "A major portion of activity of Iranian traders and businesspersons has been concentrated at Iraqi market, she said, adding that Iranian merchants and traders are facing serious problems in continuation of their trade due to the spread of coronavirus, COVID-19, conditions.

## Upto 1,500 Businesses Affected by Ransomware Attack, US Firm's CEO Says

Between 800 and 1,500 businesses around the world have been affected by a ransomware attack centered on US information technology firm Kaseya, its chief executive said on Monday. Fred Vocola, the Florida-based company's CEO, said in an interview that it was hard to estimate the precise impact of Friday's attack because those hit were mainly customers of Kaseya's customers.

Kaseya is a company which provides software tools to IT outsourcing shops: companies that typically handle back-office work for companies too small or modestly resourced to have their own tech departments. One of those tools was subverted on Friday, allowing the hackers to paralyze hundreds of businesses on all five continents. Although most of those affected have been small concerns - like dentists' offices or accountants - the disruption has been felt more keenly in Sweden, where hundreds of supermarkets had to close because their cash registers were inoperative, or New Zealand, where schools and kindergartens were knocked offline. The hackers who claimed responsibility for the

breach have demanded \$70 million to restore all the affected businesses' data, although they have indicated a willingness to temper their demands in private conversations with a cybersecurity expert and with Reuters. "We are always ready to negotiate," a representative of the hackers told Reuters earlier Monday. The representative, who spoke via a chat interface on the hackers' website, didn't provide their name. Vocola refused to say whether he was ready to take the hackers up on the offer. "I can't comment 'yes', 'no', or 'maybe'," he said when asked whether his company would talk to or pay the hackers. "No comment on anything to do with negotiating with terrorists in any way."

## Iranian Car Quality Assessed

Iran Standards and Quality Inspection Company has released a report on the quality of domestically-produced cars surveyed during the Iranian month ending May 21. The quality watchdog is a private enterprise that works on contract with the Ministry of Industries, Mining and Trade, and publishes the ranking on its website.

The report classifies the cars in five price ranges, from the cheapest costing

870 million rials (\$3,522) to the most expensive costing 10 billion rials (\$40,485).

The company quotes the vehicles' factory price, while the vehicles are sold in the open market at a much higher price. The vehicles are then ranked from one, representing the lowest quality, to a maximum of five stars.

According to the ISQI ranking, the domestically-made cars have recorded a slight improvement in recent rounds.

## Figure of Iranian vaccinated in Armenia will be revealed

Figure of Iranian vaccinated in Armenia will be revealed. Head of Iran-Armenia Joint Chamber of Commerce says the number of Iranians visiting Armenia is on the rise for COVID-19 jobs.

Reacting to the new wave of travels of Iranians to Armenia for COVID-19 jobs, Hervik Yarijanian told ILNA that the land travel has not been restored yet due to the pandemic but travels to Armenia by air are carried out.

"Armenian government has no special plan for vaccination and since they have their own quota of COVID-19 vaccines, everybody who travels Armenia can have Covid vaccine jobs."

He added that Armenian government does not get any money for vaccination and tourists are vaccinated for free, adding that there are some doctors in the place to undergo the related tests like measuring blood oxygen and pressure.

On the number of Iranians who have been vaccinated so far, he said that so far there is no exact figure and if Iran's Embassy in Armenia takes action, the figure of the vaccinated Iranians will be revealed.

Yarijanian went on to say that but the number of Iranians visiting Armenia is on the rise and all flights to Armenia have been almost full.

Meanwhile the spokesman to Iran's Civil Aviation Organization Mr. Mohammad Zibakhsh said the number of flights between Iran and Armenia will increase from next week as the Armenia Airways is to increase its flights from 5 to 7 in week and on the whole there will be 11 flights in week between the two countries.

He said no Iranian airliner is active between Tehran and Armenia and the flights are carried out by the Armenian airlines.

### Persian Gulf security talks have nothing to do with JCPOA

The Russian Permanent Representative to the International Organizations in Vienna said that the Persian Gulf security talks have nothing to do with Iran's nuclear deal, JCPOA. In a tweet on Monday, Mikhail Ulyanov wrote, "For the sake of clarity: Russia resolutely supports and advocates for regional security dialogue in the #Persian Gulf. But this is a different topic which shouldn't be mixed up with nuclear issues and the talks on #JCPOA. Security in the region must be addressed separately."

In another tweet, Ulyanov wrote, "According to #UNSC Resolution 2231 sunset provisions of #JCPOA theoretically can be extended but only upon consensus. Therefore, nobody can impose relevant discussions on #Iran against its will. In any case, sunsets aren't part of #Vienna Talks on restoration of the original JCPOA," he added.

Persian Gulf security talks have nothing to do with JCPOA. It should be noted that "sunset provisions" in 2015 nuclear deal, aka JCPOA, mean that provisions, which restrictions are defined for Iran's nuclear activities, expire after certain periods of time.

It should be noted that six rounds of negotiations have thus far been held with the aim of returning the United States to JCPOA in Vienna with the participation of the remaining countries in this agreement. Tehran has stated that lifting of all US sanctions and their verification will be a precondition for reaching an agreement in this regard.

### Region plunged into war, darkness only after Israel invention

In response to the rudeness of the ambassador of the Zionist regime to the Azerbaijan Republic, the Iranian Ambassador to Baku said that the region plunged into war and darkness only after the invention of the Zionist regime.

In a Tuesday tweet, Seyyed Abbas Mousavi reacted to the remarks of the Zionist regime's ambassador to Baku, saying, "Our region plunged into war & #darkness only after the #invention of the #Zionist regime."

"It won't take too long until the region, once again, witnesses peace, light, prosperity & peaceful coexistence of all nations," he added.

The Zionist regime's Ambassador to Baku George Deek in response to the electricity shortage in Iraq claimed, "Wherever the Iran regime goes, darkness follows."

## Iran's stance on JCPOA not to change with admin. change

Iranian Foreign Ministry Spokesman said that Iran's position on the JCPOA and the lifting of sanctions will not change with the change of administration.



Speaking in his weekly press conference, Saeed Khatibzadeh answered questions on a wide range of topics.

Iran's position on JCPOA, lifting of sanctions not to change with change of administration

Regarding the position of some Western officials on the need to wait for the new administration of the Islamic Republic of Iran, Khatibzadeh said, "Iran's position on the JCPOA and the lifting of sanctions is one of the principled positions of the Establishment and will not change with the change of administration."

"Therefore, if an agreement is reached, the administration of Mr. Raeisi will be loyal to it, because contrary to the approach of some other parties, adherence to the given commitments and promises is always a principle for the Islamic Republic of Iran," he added.

"The progress made in the Vienna talks is a fact acknowledged by all parties to the talks, although there are still important issues that largely need to be decided by the other parties, especially the United States. In fact, the finalization of the agreement to revive the JCPOA depends on the political will of the other parties to make tough decisions on their part," the spokesman said on the progress of the negotiations.

He went on to say, "Iranian delegation seeks to reach an agreement as soon as possible and to lift the oppressive sanctions against the Iranian people. However, we do not set any deadline for reaching an agreement that serves the interests of the Iranian people. Negotiations will continue until a favorable agreement is reached for Iran. As has been said many times, we are in no



hurry to reach an agreement, but we will not allow the negotiations to become protracted."

Iran has no intention of interfering in internal affairs of Iraq

In response to a question about the claim published in some Western media that the United States was sending a message to Iran about the recent attacks on Syria and Iraq through diplomatic channels, Khatibzadeh said, "The Islamic Republic of Iran has always emphasized that the language of force and threat will not be of any use for the security of the region. The United States must realize that its regional goals will not be achieved by bullying but rather, its situation in West Asia will be aggravated."

Emphasizing that Iran has no intention of interfering in the internal affairs of Iraq, he added, "The repeated and announced attacks by the United States against the positions of the Iraqi and Syrian forces on the border between the two countries are only to hit the main deterrents of ISIL members and to strengthen the remnants of this terrorist organization."

Iran expresses concern over Zionist regime's intention to join African Union

In reaction to the intention of the Zionist regime to apply for the position of observer member in the African Union, the FM spokesman expressed deep concern and strong opposition of the Islamic Republic of Iran to such a move.

In order to demonstrate their political determination to adhere to the Palestinian cause, he called on African Union member states to respect the decisions of important international organizations such as the Organization of Islamic Cooperation to oppose any action to grant membership or positions to the occupying regime in international and regional organizations.

"Yousef bin Ahmad Al-Othaimen, the Secretary-General of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation in a letter to Foreign Minister Mohammad Javad Zarif, while expressing gratitude for the commitment of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the principles of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation and our country's support for joint action of Islamic countries on issues related to the Islamic Ummah, has expressed deep concern over the news received from some official sources that the Zionist regime intends to apply for an observer position in the African Union (AU)," Khatibzadeh noted.

### Vienna talks can reach their goal in coming weeks: Maas

German Foreign Minister Heiko Maas said Monday he is confident of reaching a deal to save the JCPOA in the coming weeks.

"We think (the talks) can reach their goal," he told reporters in Madrid after a gathering of the Stockholm Initiative, a group of 16 states working towards nuclear disarmament. "I think we'll get there in the coming weeks," Maas added of the Iran talks that resumed in April in Vienna. This is while the Russian Permanent Representative to the International Organizations in Vienna Mikhail Ulyanov in a tweet pointed to the long pause until the start of the next round of Vienna talks, saying that expectations about the outcome of the JCPOA revival talks were not met until the anniversary of the agreement on July 15.

Referring to some attempts to include other topics in the Vienna talks, Mikhail Ulyanov in a tweet on Monday wrote, "In the context of #ViennaTalks, some analysts and officials advocate for addressing new topics such as regional security and missiles."



### Iran Among World's Top Air Defense Powers: Commander

The significant advances that Iran has made in the air defense industry has turned the country into one of the world's top powers with the capability to detect every aerial object in its airspace and even outside the borders, a senior commander said.

During a visit to a military base in the northwestern city of Oroumiyeh, Air Defense Commander Brigadier General Alireza Sabahi Fard said Iran has developed such great capabilities and homegrown systems that the air defense forces can detect every aircraft and small flying object in the country's airspace and outside the frontiers.

"The Islamic Republic of Iran is among the top powers in air defense, not only in the region but in the world," he added.

The commander also highlighted Iran's self-sufficiency in manufacturing various air defense equipment, saying the country's deterrent power has reached such a high level that the enemies do not dare to pose any aerial threat.

Iranian officials have repeatedly underscored that the country will not hesitate to strengthen its military capabilities, including its missile power, which are entirely meant for defense, and that Iran's defense capabilities will be never subject to negotiations.

In February 2018, Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyed Ali Khamenei called for efforts to maintain and boost Iran's defense capabilities, hitting back at the enemies for disputing the country's missile program. "Without a moment of hesitation, the country must move to acquire whatever is necessary for defense, even if the whole world is opposed to it," the Leader said at the time.

### Defense min. condoles Philippines over plane crash

Iranian Minister of Defense Brigadier General Amir Hatami expressed his deep condolences to his Philippine counterpart Delfin Lorenzana over the plane crash in this country on Sunday.

"I was deeply saddened to hear the news of crash of a C-130 military plane which led to the death of a number of army officers," he stated.

"On behalf of myself and Armed Forces of the Islamic Republic of Iran, I seize this opportunity to express my condolences to the Armed Forces of the Republic of Philippines and bereaved families of the victims of this tragic incident and pray the Almighty God to bestow forbearance and patience over the irreparable loss."

On July 4, a Philippine Air Force plane with 92 soldiers and crew members aboard crashed on the southern island of Jolo on Sunday, officials said. 52 deaths have so far been confirmed. The C-130, an American-built turboprop, is used by militaries around the world and is sometimes kept in service for decades.

### Honesty in Reporting News Among Resistance Front's Major

The secretary general of Lebanon's Hezbollah resistance movement denounced the US government's decision to seize and block dozens of pro-resistance websites, saying they promote the rights of Palestinians as well as humanitarian values.

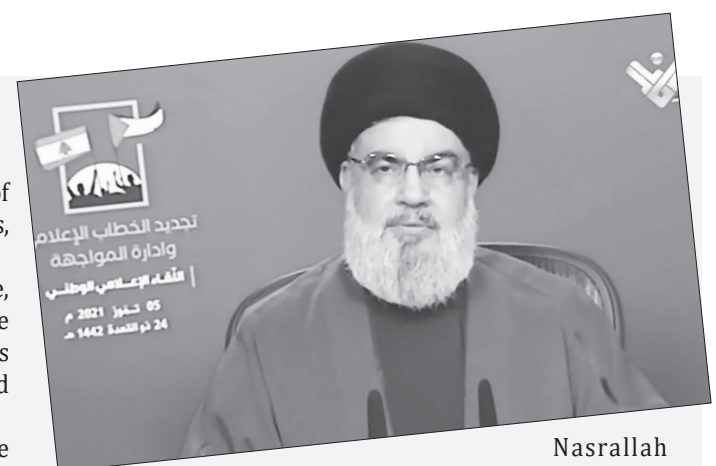
"It is necessary to develop media influence in parallel with beefing up our military might. Media can play a key role with regards to the fight against (Israeli) occupation of Palestine. Pro-resistance media outlets break news on victories notched up by resistance fighters," Seyed Hassan Nasrallah said in a televised speech on Monday. He added, "The discourse of pro-resistance media pivots on righteousness, and promotion of Palestinians' rights as well as humanitarian values. They should primarily focus on national demands in Palestine and elsewhere in the (Middle East) region." The Hezbollah chief went on to say that outlets supporting the

resistance front have substantially contributed to the victories of resistance forces through reliance on facts, studies and researches, and they have built new realities in the region.

"In our campaign against anti-resistance psychological warfare, we would neither count on illusions nor fabrications. Among the most important points of strength that the resistance front enjoys is honesty in reporting news and developments," Nasrallah pointed out.

He went on to say that pro-resistance networks can mobilize the world public opinion in support of Palestine, emphasizing they must honor honesty to build further credibility.

"Pro-resistance media have developed remarkably in recent decades... The outlets have exposed the true face of the (Israeli) enemy, which claimed to be invincible," the Hezbollah leader noted.



Nasrallah said, "The enemy takes some satellite channels off the air and seizes pro-resistance news website domains, because of its fear of the latter's influence. We have to exchange our expertise in the field of media, and take advantage of social media platforms."

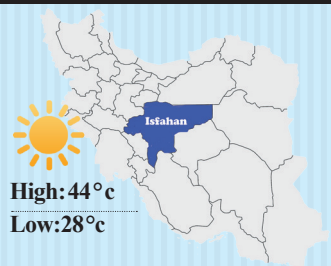

## At Least 150 People Fatally Shot in More than 400 US Shootings over July 4 Weekend

At least 150 people were killed by gun violence in more than 400 shootings across the US during the Fourth of July weekend as major cities nationwide confront a surge in violent crime, according to data compiled by the Gun Violence Archive.

The data, which includes the number of shooting incidents and gun violence victims nationally over a 72-hour period from Friday through Sunday, is still evolving and will be updated.

In New York, where gun violence has been rising to levels not seen in years, there were 26 victims from 21 shootings from Friday to Sunday, a decrease from the same period last year when 30 people were shot in 25 shootings, the New York Police Department said.

On July 4, the city experienced 12 shooting incidents that involved 13 victims, an increase from last year when there were eight shootings and eight victims, according to the NYPD.

So far this year, gun violence incidents in New York have spiked almost 40% over the same period in 2020, with 767 shootings and 885 victims. In Chicago, after Police Superintendent David Brown raised concerns before the "most challenging weekend of the year" for police, 83 people were shot, including 14 killed, in shootings from 6 p.m. Friday to 6 a.m. Monday, according to a CNN review of preliminary Chicago Police Department data. The injured included a 5-year-old girl wounded on Sunday afternoon and a 6-year-old girl shot early Monday. One of the 14 people killed was a member of the Illinois Army National Guard, WLS reported. His family identified him on social media as Chrysalis Carvajal, though the Cook County medical examiner has not officially released his name. Lt. Col. Brad Leighton confirmed that Carvajal was assigned to the Company L, Recruitment Sustainment Program, Recruiting and Retention Battalion, of the Illinois Army National Guard.

"(Carvajal) was new to the Illinois National Guard and was to be assigned to a transportation unit. He had recently completed Army basic training," Leighton said. "Our hearts go out Pvt. 1st Class Carvajal's family and friends."

On July 4, the city experienced 12 shooting incidents that involved 13 victims, an increase from last year when there were eight shootings and eight victims, according to the NYPD.

Two Chicago police officers were injured in an overnight shooting as an individual opened fire while officers were dispersing a crowd of several thousand people and made more than 60 arrests, police said. Both are expected to survive.

Unlike other cities experiencing a spike in violent crime, the homicide rate in Chicago through June is 2% lower than the same period in 2020. The number of victims is still 14% higher. A reason for the drop was a less violent June where Chicago saw a 20% drop in homicides compared to last year (98 instead of 78), a 13% drop in shootings (416 compared to 363) and an 8% decrease in shooting victims (540 compared to 499).

In suburban Atlanta, golf professional Gene Siller was fatally shot at a country club on Saturday, and police are still looking for the suspect, according to Cobb County police. Siller, 41, was found unresponsive with an "apparent gunshot wound to the head" and was pronounced dead at the scene, police said. Two other gunshot victims were also found on the course.

Police are still searching for the suspect, who has not been identified.

There were several mass shootings over the holiday weekend. CNN defines a mass shooting as an incident with four or more people killed or wounded by gunfire, excluding the shooter.

Eight people were injured early Sunday morning in a shooting near a car wash in Fort Worth, Texas, after an argument between a group of men, according to a Fort Worth police news release. One of the men left during the argument, returned with a gun and began firing "toward groups of people," and multiple people returned gunfire, the release said. Most of the victims, who are in stable condition, are believed to be innocent bystanders, police said.

In Norfolk, Virginia, four children were shot on Friday afternoon, including a 6-year-old girl who was initially reported to be suffering life-threatening injuries but is now in stable condition, according to Norfolk police. The victims also included a 14-year-old boy, a 16-year-old girl, and a 16-year-old boy, all of whom are expected to fully recover.

## Canada, the cultural genocide, humanitarian catastrophe

The discovery of the remains of 215 indigenous children in a mass grave on the site of a boarding school in Canada, which is a case of "cultural genocide", indicates a humanitarian catastrophe and a clear violation of human rights.

Indigenous persecution in North America, especially in the United States and Canada, has a long and painful history. Artifacts from the lives of Canada's first indigenous people who lived in one part of the country for a long time, as well as archeological excavations in the northernmost part of the country, the Yukon, show that the natives were the original owners of the land and have lived in the area for 9,500 years. In 1497, a British sailor named John Cabot established a British colony after reaching the shores of Newfoundland. About 40 years later, a French sailor named Jacques Cartier stepped into the mouth of the Saint Laurent River near Montreal and established French colonies. The natives of this land, who were hospitable according to their culture, welcomed the white Europeans. The name Canada, derived from the Indian word Kanata meaning "village", was given to this land and, on the advice of the colonizers, was recorded in the maps in 1547 under the same Canadian name. Indigenous Canadians, who had always lived in peace, were no longer welcome with the arrival of wealthy Europeans who were thinking of colonialism, and their rights were violated at various times. After the formation of a country called Canada in the 19th century, the government called Indigenous people uncivilized and, in order to "introduce Indigenous people to modern culture," separated Indigenous Canadian children from their families and tribes and placed them in boarding schools. The main goal of the colonialists was to completely alienate the new generations from their native culture in order to accept the white Europeans as the owners of civilization.

Under the policy, tens of thousands of Native Canadian children from hundreds of tribes were sent to such schools and were allowed to return to their tribe and family only after finishing high school.

the forced removal of indigenous children from their families and the ban on speaking the indigenous language or engaging in cultural activities related to that tribe not only alienated them from the Hood culture but also had devastating effects such as sexual abuse. Ten years ago, the Committee to Investigate Canada's Indigenous Children Segregation Committee released new details on the abuse, sexual and physical abuse of Indigenous children.

According to the BBC Farsi, "George Manuel, one of the people who was in these schools in the 1920s, said: 'All the native students were suffering from hunger. Schools were also cold in the winters and unsanitary. Students were also exposed to measles, influenza, tuberculosis and other infectious diseases, and many died.' But the discovery of mass graves belongs to missing children whose deaths were not announced. Some of the remains belong to children about three years old, whose cause and time of death are still unknown. The remains were found in a boarding school founded in 1890 during the rule of the Catholic Church and closed in 1978. Indigenous Canadians have long asked the Canadian government, which claims to defend human rights, to identify mass graves in boarding schools, but Canadian officials have refused to do so. Now that mass graves have been found, evidence shows that there have been at least 3,201 deaths in boarding schools. Following the revelation of this tragic tragedy, the Prime Minister of Canada, Justin Trudeau, was forced to express his shock and concern at the discovery of the remains of these children, calling it a painful reminder of a dark and shameful chapter in Canadian history. The Canadian government tried to blame the Catholic Church for its crimes and to share the burden of the scandal. In implementing the policy, people were encouraged to attack 10 churches on Canadian National Day, and Canadian police linked the attacks to Indigenous anger over the discovery of their children's bodies and a history of injustice. Since then, several churches have been set on fire in Canada's more indigenous western provinces.
